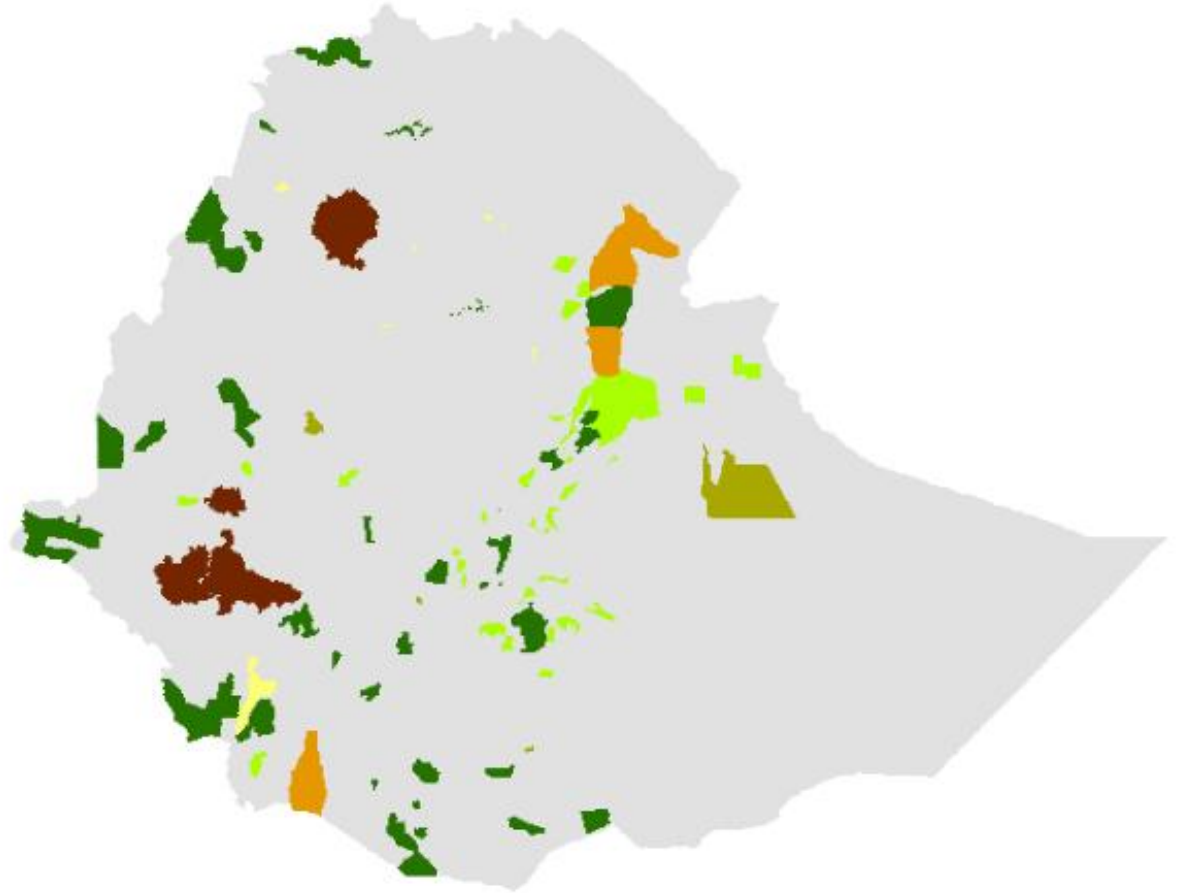

Background

- 14 % PA coverage (Scholte et al., 2025)
- Global Biodiversity Target 30x30
- Management responsibility under federal, regional, and community
- Annual value of PAs was estimated at US\$ 325 million (Hugo, 2015)



Finance Needed

- Global average is US\$ 893 /km², developing countries average is US\$ 157/km²
- Ethiopia's expenditure is below US\$5/km² or 0.1% of the national GDP (EWCA)
- US\$ 169 million required for EWCA Pas (Hugo et al., 2024)

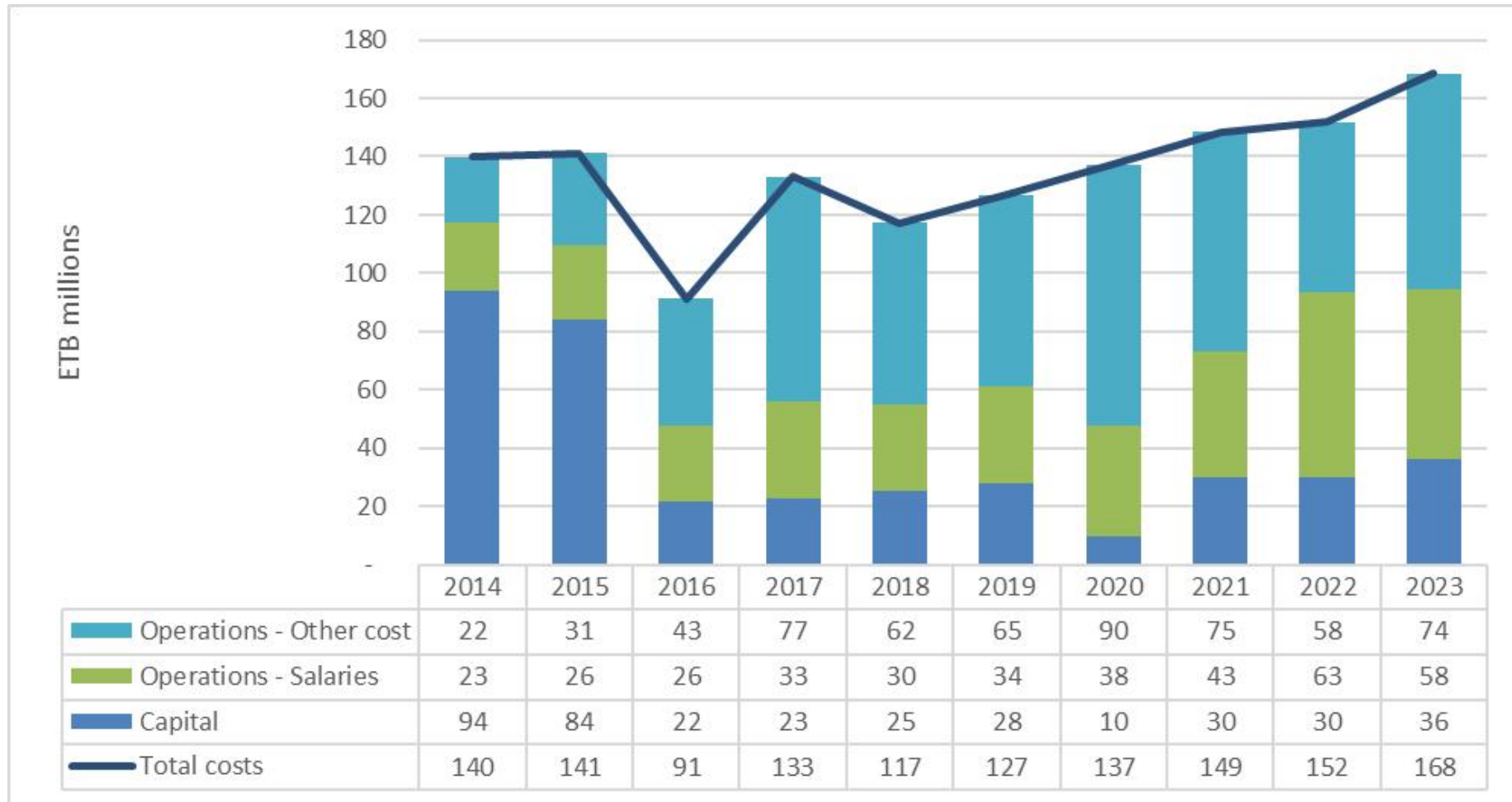

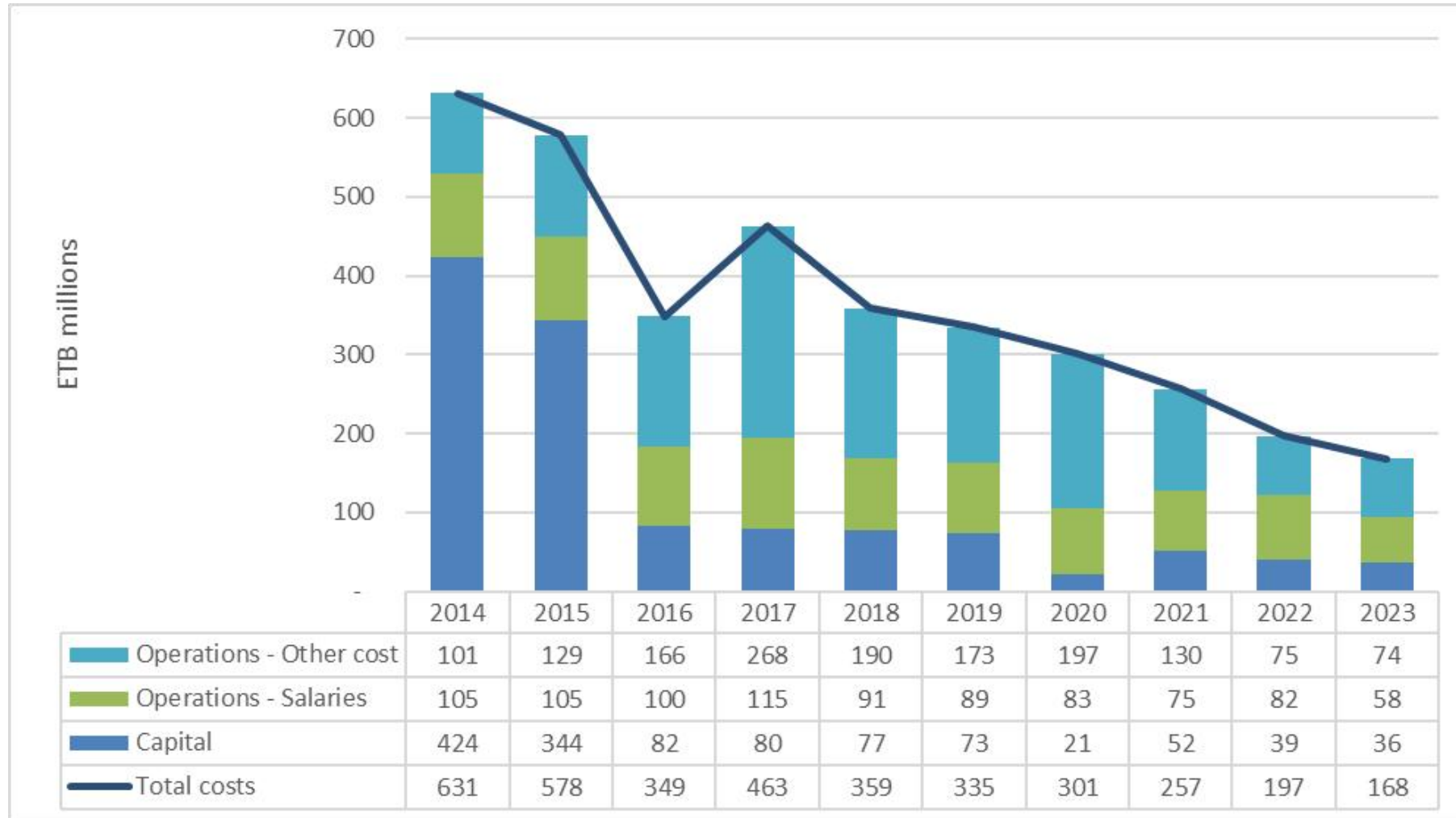

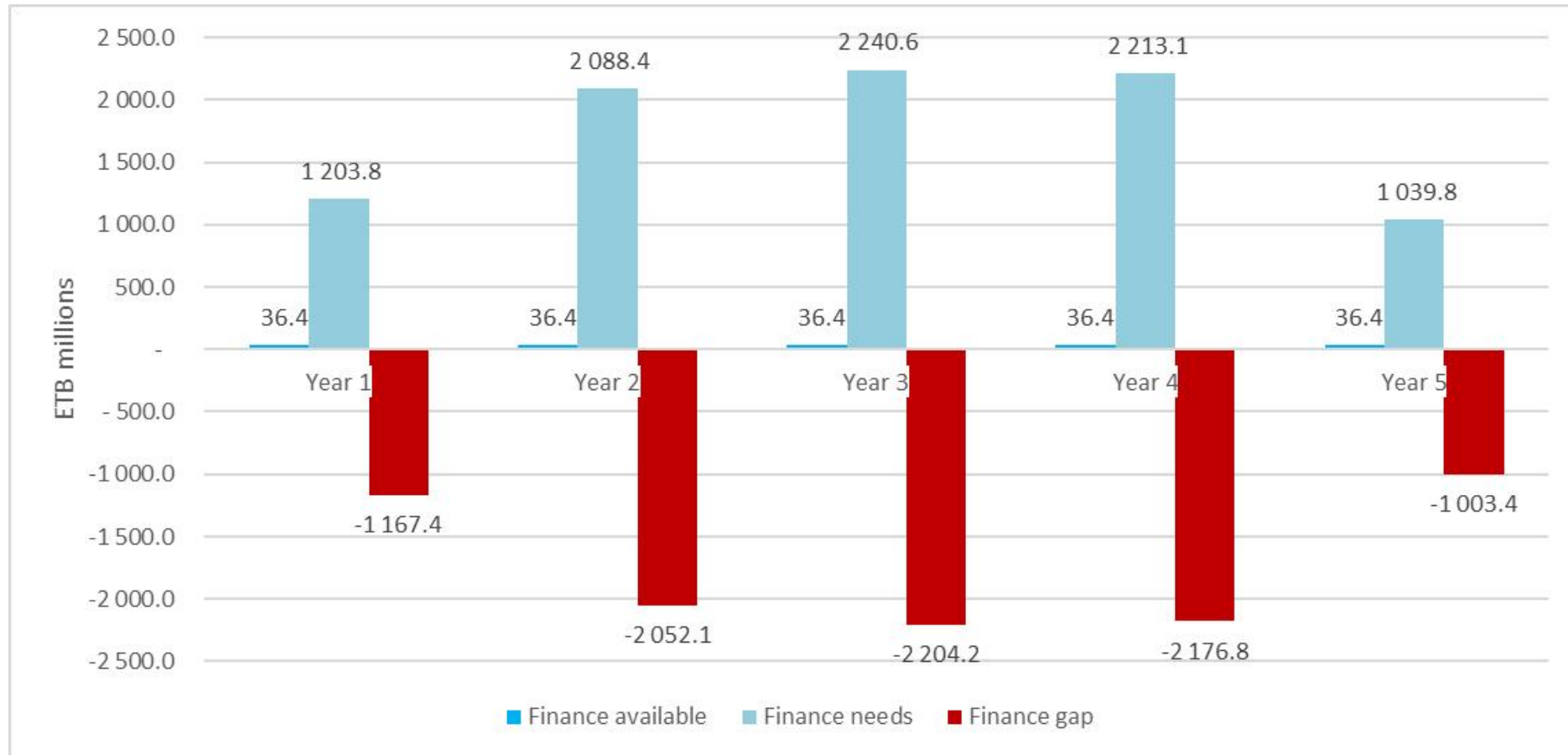
EWCA overall budget per category



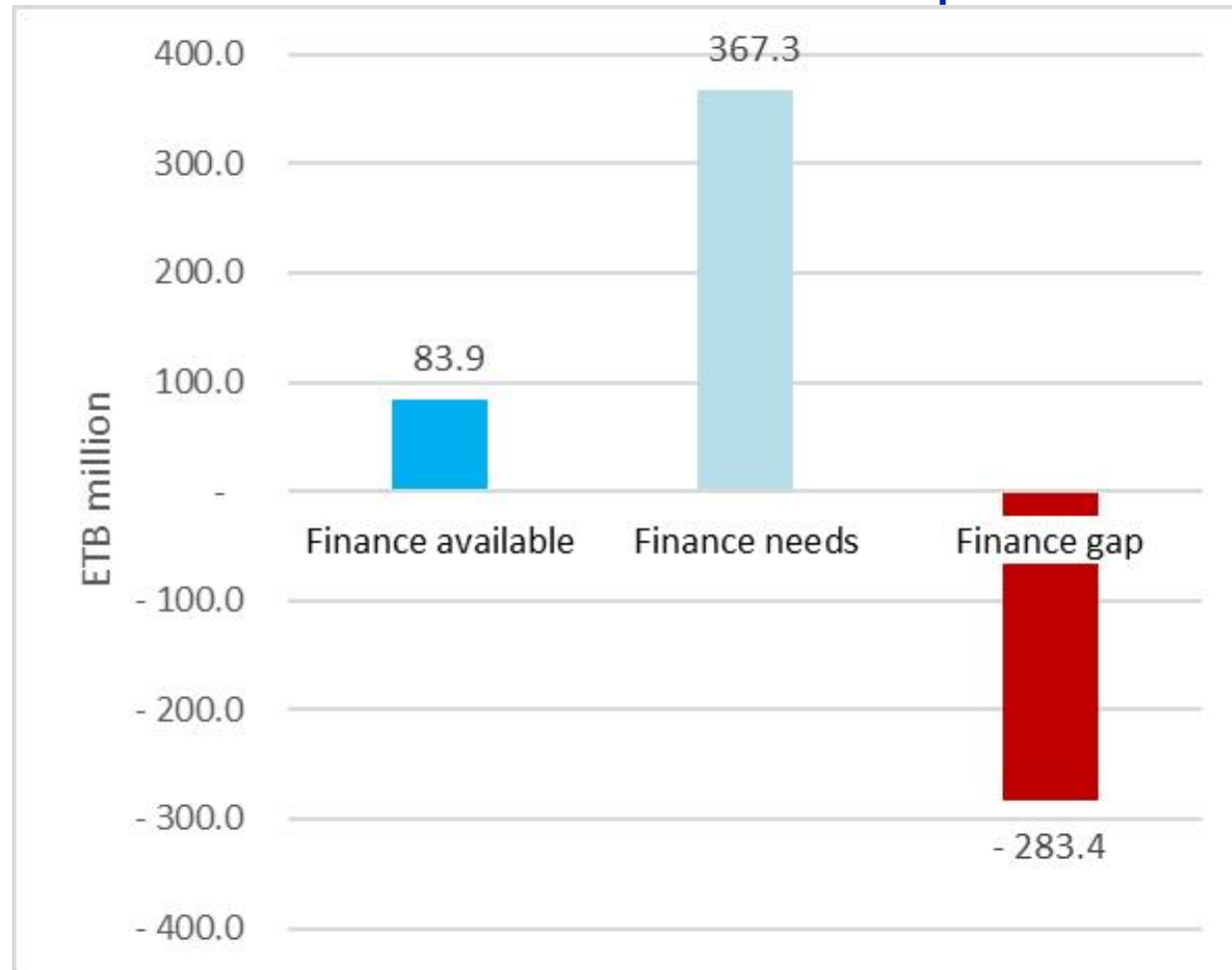
EWCA overall budget per category – inflation-adjusted (in today's money)



Finance Needs Assessment – capital for all parks

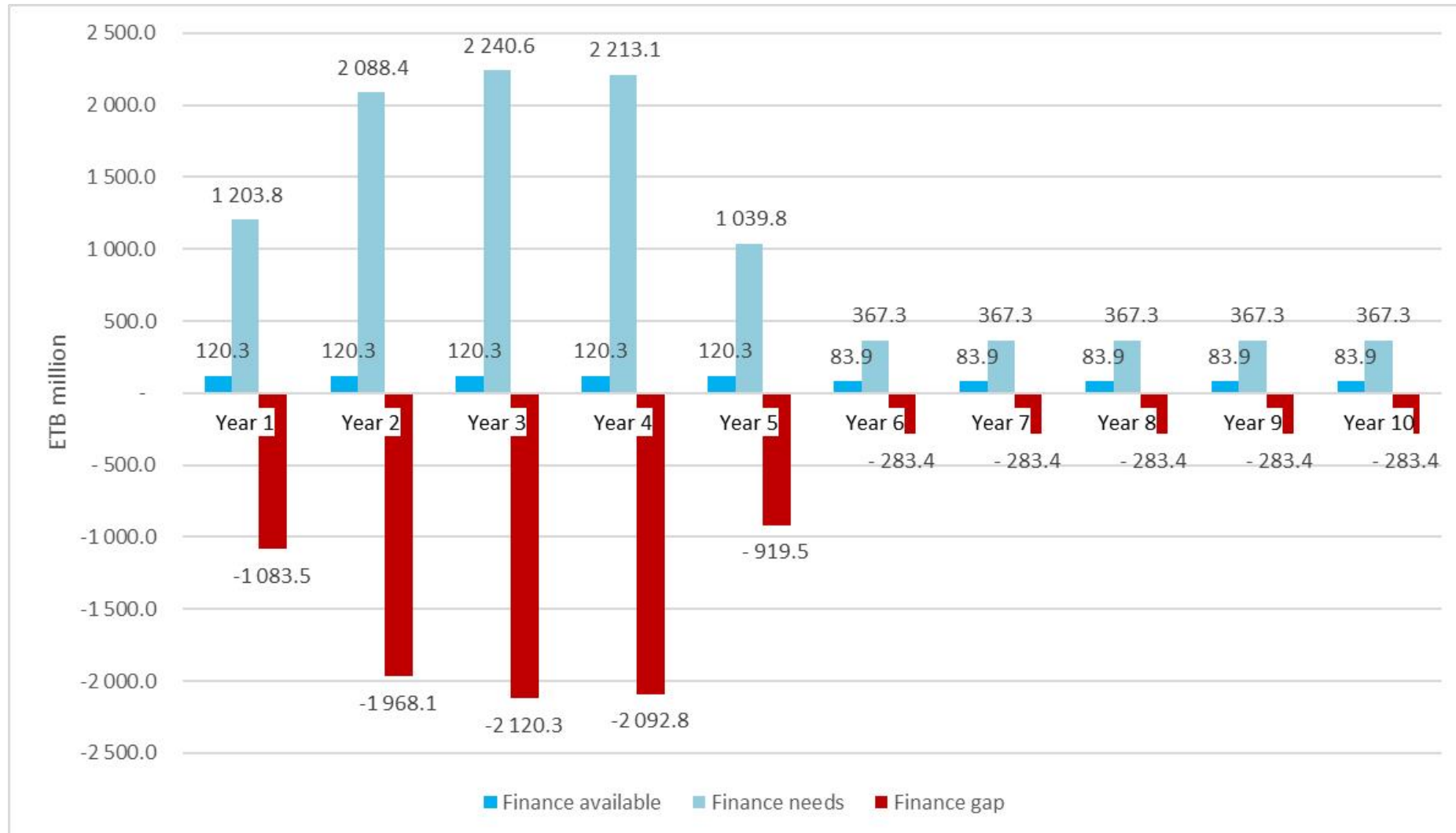


Finance Needs Assessment – annual operations for all parks

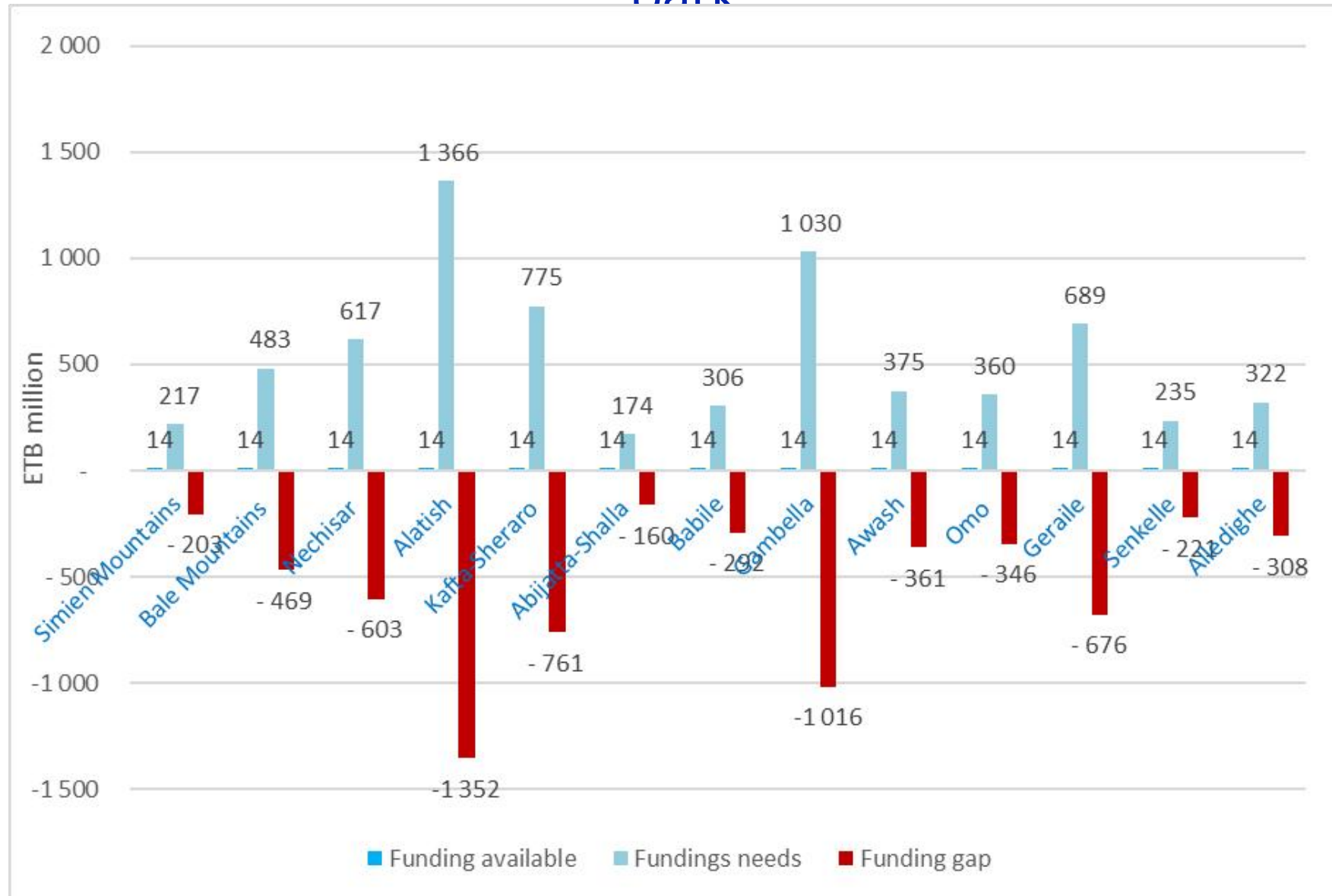

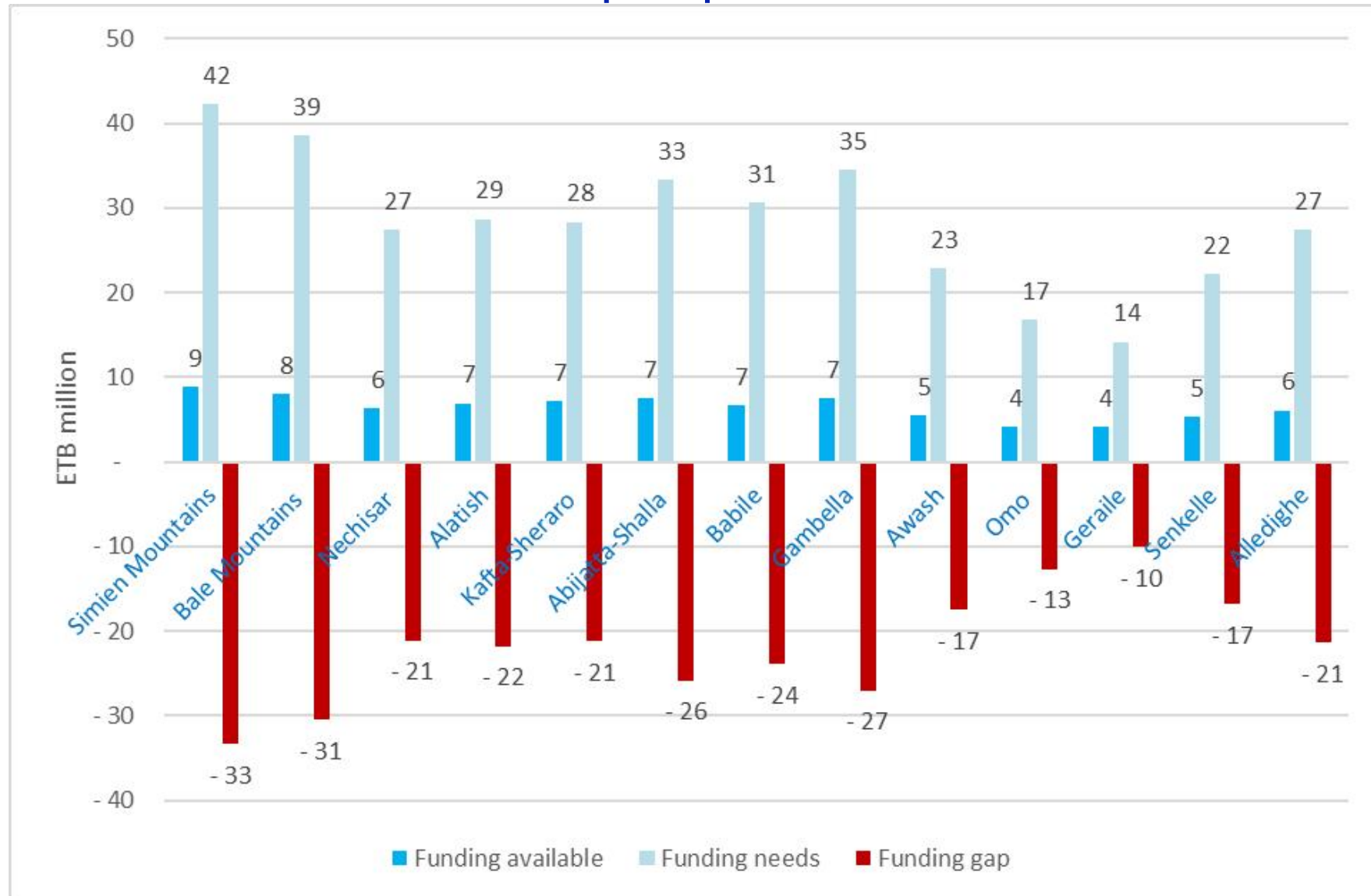
Finance Needs Assessment – total capital and operations for all parks

Financing mechanisms/solutions

1. Delegated management of selected parks
2. Review and update park fees (reinvest)
3. Expansion of tourism concession
4. Establishment of a Conservation Trust Fund (CTF)
5. Expand climate change finance
6. Establish Payments for Ecosystem Services (PES) schemes
7. Increased efficiency in management expenditure
 - Fund absorption capacity
 - Salary vs non-salary operational expenses

PPP categories

- Delegated, Co-management and Community management
- For-profit and for-nonprofit arrangements
- Conservation NGOs such as APN, AWF, and FZS fit in the non-profit arrangement where intervention mainly focuses on improved ecosystem services (some ESs could be sellable for other private/public agencies, investors, etc.).
- While tourism operators fit in the for-profit PPP arrangement aimed to generate financial returns, they could buy or be taxed for the improved ecosystem services.
- 70/30 new modality introduced for targeted PAs (Awash, BMNP, NSNP).
- Revenue retention (reinvesting) and privileges for incentives are outstanding issues.

- Online Booking and Digital Payment Options integrate DMMP with TeleBirr, Ebirr, and M-PESA.
